

CAROLYN WITHERSPOON



CAROLYN WITHERSPOON, BSN, RN

Upon graduating from West Texas State University with a Bachelor of Science Nursing degree in 1977, Carolyn Witherspoon began her nursing career in the rural community of Dimmitt, Texas. She held positions as a staff nurse, nursing supervisor and nursing director until 1998 in the rural settings. Her areas of nursing practice have been in women and children's health. As Mrs. Witherspoon puts it though, "I have a passion for rural communities and a strong will to improve health care for residents of the Texas Panhandle."

In March of 1998, she began employment with the Coalition of Health Services as Quality Assurance Director. In November of 2000, she was appointed as the Executive Director following 6 months as Interim and continues in that role today. The Coalition of Health Services, Inc. is a 501c3 not for profit organized in 1996. The Board consists of CEO's or their designees representing two tertiary for profit hospitals in Amarillo and 12 rural hospitals in the Texas Panhandle. The purpose of the Coalition is to enhance rural health through coordinated and collaborative efforts of the member rural health care facilities, their partners and to support ongoing rural health initiatives in individual communities. These entities serve over 450,000 people living over a sparsely populated 26,000 square miles. The Coalition contracts with Texas Department of State Health Services and the Texas Department of Health and Human Resources to administer funds to providers in 33 counties of Health Service Region 1.

Under Mrs. Witherspoon's leadership, the Coalition over the years has been involved with a plethora of grant funded projects to meet the health care needs of the Panhandle. (As a matter of fact, the list of grant funded projects is too numerous to list!) The Coalition partners with other community based organizations to provide information and education throughout the Panhandle region for a variety of health related services. Most recently, private grant funding and local foundations have contributed financial support to the development of Gateway to Health Careers. This is a collaborative project between AACAL, TTUHSC SimCentral, the Coalition and the Texas Panhandle Coalition for Nursing to promote health career training in rural high schools.

In 2013, the prestigious Outstanding Network Leader of the Year from the National Cooperative of Health Networks (NCHN) was awarded to Mrs. Witherspoon. NCHN is a membership organization comprised of health network leaders from throughout the nation of which, she serves as President.

Mrs. Witherspoon is an active participant on a number of local, regional and national advisory boards including Amarillo College School of Nursing, West Texas A&M University, Panhandle Behavioral Health Alliance, just to name a few. Her name is known well at the offices of state legislators, local elected officials, county judges, school superintendents, administrators, etc.

Kudos to Mrs. Witherspoon for a lifetime of championing nursing and impacting the wellbeing of the Texas Panhandle.




